The above table details information on the volume of our Support for Learning (ASN) classes over the previous five years. Whilst there has been a reduction in the number of classes, we have increased the class size to protect student places.

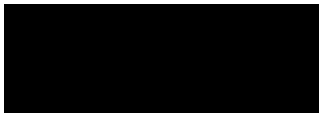
